#### Graphic Book Images, Ugh! Part One

own ad, and this is where we're going with this article. Hopefully, I'm going to help you stop saying, "Ugh".

First we'll start with digital ads. You may have to do some digging to figure out where your commands are on the program you're using, especially since you may not have the same program I use.

Dpi is dots per inch.

This is a 72 dpi image, jpg, at 3 x 2.



Hopefully, by the end of this article you'll have a better grip on understanding book graphics, images, and the difference for digital and print ads.

The language for photo programs are similar. You don't need to have the knowledge to create an ad. That's what graphic artists are for, that's why you pay them to create a beautiful cover, and/or ad. But, you should know what you're receiving and how it can be used.

There are multiple formats: jpg, jpeg, jfif, gif, bmp, png, tiff, and pdf to name a few. If you want to know what format your image is, you can hover over the image on your computer and it will tell you what the format is, or item type, and dimension (300 x 450). It may or may not tell you the bit size, for example, 1mg.

As an author, there are many times when you want to create your



Compacting the images helps save space on your computer but doesn't keep the picture at the quality needed. This image will look a little better in the digital issue. However, it doesn't do the image justice.

Below is the same image, 72 dpi, jpg, at 15 x 10. The size is manually adjusted for pdf to 3 x 2 without creating pixelation. When you resize manually, it compresses the picture avoiding pixilation.

When I say manually adjusted, I have highlighted the image and used the size-square with my curser to shrink the picture. I didn't resize it in a photo program.

How can you make your images look sharp and professional? I prefer jpg or png when I create ads for myself and for the magazine, regardless of whether it is for digital or print.

Resizing incorrectly can effect color, pixilation, and distortion. For digital ads, I prefer using 150 to 225 dpi. Depending on the photo program you use depends on how you will resize your image. The main reason why I prefer the 150 to 225 is because text tends to pixelate more than a picture. If I raise the dpi from 72 or 96 to 150 or 225, it

avoids text pixelation.




"Thank you for seeing me," Abby said to the big man standing in front of her. She took a seat across from him as he returned to his desk.


"I have a map, Mr. Logan. It was willed to me when my grandfather died. In the past few months, I've been making preparations to find it, but I need your help."

In Jodie Slaughter's *Bet on It*, Aja Owens and Walker Abbott make a bingosex pact, allowing them to satisfy their fierce sexual desire/thirst for each other. Though they agree to keep emotions out of it, Aja and Walker catch feelings because emotions won't be denied, especially when the connection/desire is this intense and powerful.

Aja first encounters the man of her dreams while having a panic attack in Piggly Wiggly's frozen foods section. To her surprise, her favorite bingo buddy introduces him as her estranged grandson. After one bingo game, she knows he will be a problem when she already has more than enough of those in her life. His grandmother and the diner's peach cobbler are all he cares for

in Greenbelt. After 10+ years, only his Gram could drag him back to the town holding bad memories of his childhood trauma and baggage. So he's counting down the days until her injuries heal and he can return to his real life. But that's before Aja, who changes everything in his life changes him.

From the opening scene, the characters and story draw you in. Slaughter's beautifully written exploration of Aja's and Walker's journey from strangers—living/struggling with anxiety/mental illness—to friends who make a bingosex pact to lovers who fall in love, despite themselves, grabs hold of the heart and mind. Her story is original, thoughtful, and full of emotion and heart, with fantastic pacing, excellent worldbuilding, vivid description, and colorful and lively dialogue and character interactions.

Slaughter wonderfully develops and evolves complex, likable, imperfect, and sympathetic characters through interactions infused with the full spectrum of emotions, shared experiences, and pain that quicken and deepen the connection between them. Walker and Aja's sweet, funny, sexy, intimate, and emotional banter/interactions are among the novel's best moments. Additionally, their relationships, conversations, and interactions with friends and family are authentic, dynamic, and funny, offering insight into Aja and Walker.

Slaughter's portrayal of anxiety/mental illness and its impact on the characters' daily lives is nuanced and thought provoking. Her description of Walker and Aja's anxiety-panic, trauma, and PTSD- is vivid and visceral, making the reader feel like they are with Aja and Walker in those debilitating, emotional, frightening moments.

Bet on It is a sweet, unbelievably sexy, funny, steamy, emotional, compelling, and profoundly romantic novel.

While Hannah looks like a kindergarten teacher, she can kill with a ballpoint pen, dinner napkin, or a wine bottle opener. She desperately wants an assignment to Korea, anywhere outside the US, to escape her life! But instead, she's protecting Jack from a middle aged, corgi breeding stalker.

Jack dropped from the public eye after a family tragedy. After his mom's illness, Jack must go home to be with her and his family at their Texas ranch. Hannah goes undercover, pretending she's Jack's girlfriend to hide the fact that he needs protection from a stalker. Hannah's used to protecting people and keeping her distance, but spending time with Jack/his family as his girlfriend is outside her comfort zone. The longer she's undercover, the more she learns about him and herself. Her heart's in danger because there's nowhere for her to run. Can she keep Jack safe without losing her heart? Can they safely protect their secrets without them blowing up in their faces?

Center's narrative and vibrant writing are richly detailed with emotion. She develops complex, imperfect, relatable characters whom you cannot help but love. Hannah excels as a bodyguard. However, she keeps aspects of herself tightly locked down. Jack's nothing like she expects. A down-to-earth, authentic sweetheart who's funny, charming, gentle, and sarcastic, Jack's haunted by trauma—a tragic accident and loss.

Though Hannah's determined to keep her usual distance from Jack, he breaks down her barriers. Their lives are different, but their closely held *personas*, hidden behind façades, are similar. They perfectly match, balancing each other, helping each other heal.



# Accomplished: A Georgie Darcy Novel

Amanda Quain's Accomplished is a modern retelling of Austen's Pride and Prejudice from Georgiana Darcy's POV. It explores Georgie and Wickham Foster's relationship and its fallout if transported to the present day. Quain also examines Georgie and Fitzwilliam's relationship.

Georgie's Pemberley Academy classmates believe she should have been expelled after "The Incident" with Wickham last year instead of him. But, while the family name helped her escape expulsion, she cannot escape her big brother Fitz's disappointment or her classmate's scorn. And, she cannot seem to let go of Wickham.

Georgie starts her junior year wanting to prove she's not an embarrassment to the Darcy family name by becoming the "Perfect Darcy":

- 1. Rebuild her reputation with the marching band.
- 2. Forget about Wickham and his lies.
- 3. Distract Fitz by matchmaking him with Lizzie Bennet.

Georgie draws fellow bandmate and friend Avery into her plans. But she must make peace with who she is, finding her way when the weight of living up to the Darcy name and striving for perfection overwhelms her before she loses everything.

Surprisingly more angsty and intense than expected, Accomplished is balanced with sweet, lighthearted, and humorous moments. Vivid description, and deft worldbuilding, draw the reader into the characters' lives and the story. Quain skillfully develops fallible, relatable, and likable characters. Georgie Darcy's not okay. Betrayed by her first "boyfriend," she's grieving losing her parents and adjusting to changes in her relationship with her brother. It's frustrating watching her tear herself/her life apart over Wickham. It's crazy how she runs back to her feelings for him and that relationship for comfort. But she's unable to believe how much Fitz loves her and that he could never hate her.

Georgiana's a hot mess. Georgie can't change it until she gets to the root of why/how it got that way, lets go of the guilt and shame, and forgives herself.

Quain brilliantly uses Georgiana and Wickham to explore the dynamics of an abusive relationship. Avery's nothing like Wickham. He's sweet, encouraging, forgiving, and not a user. Quain's Lizzie and Fitz are likable and amusing. Georgiana's most likable in her scenes with Avery and Lizzie because she relaxes, letting herself be and live.

Accomplished's an entertaining exploration of Georgiana Darcy's journey of self-discovery and belonging after the devastation inflicted by an abusive relationship with Wickham.

Abe's creative mythology, deft worldbuilding, and vivid description draw readers into the novel. While she creates a story about magic, people who can wield magic, and magical places, the characters are still bound by natural laws and experience the ups and downs of human existence. Consequently, the novel's more angsty and emotional than expected, but Abe nicely balances this with sweet, lighthearted, and humorous moments.

The characters evolve with Abe's fascinating story. Ellie longs to be seen and break out of her shell—free to be herself—but sharing her magic could get her kicked out of the magic world.

Abe beautifully examines the difficulty of losing a friend who's been by your side for most of your life—like losing part of yourself. She presents an irresistible mystery. Jack seems to still care deeply about Ellie, but it's hard to reconcile that with his abandonment of her and their friendship and his cold, aloof treatment. Jack's reasons are complicated and heartbreaking, and the pain he caused is palpable. Angsty, funny, introspective, and sweet, *The Charmed List* is an enchanting, entertaining,

High school seniors Isabel Maier and Mateo Luna discover love and unexpected truths about themselves while designing/building battle robots. Because she fears the future, Bel avoids thinking about planning for it. One of her teachers sees her talent for engineering and forces her to join the robotics club. Unfortunately, the team's boys ignore her, and Neelam, the team's only other girl, doesn't like her. Bel and Teo's start is antagonistic because of differences in personality, ideas, and style conflicts. However, they grow closer while building/designing robots, transitioning into friends, and verging on more.

Follmuth's vibrant descriptions and relatable, authentic characters capture the readers' imaginations. She creates a world of characters rich in individuality and diversity of interests, cultures, and ethnicities, taking time to explore the characters' lives and cultures with a down-to-earth, natural, warm tone. Lively, humorous, candid dialogue and character interactions, excellent worldbuilding, exciting robotics competitions, and the empowering and sincere relationships Bel shares with her BFFs are novel highlights. With nuance, Follmuth candidly depicts the sexism, misogyny, racism, and unfairness young girls/women of color experience in STEM education and careers.

Bel's many and varied talents

and characteristics make her fascinating. Her innate ability to make things work efficiently without having scientific/mathematical foundations is remarkable and admirable. Many readers, especially teens, can relate to Bel's insecurity and inability to view her talent through the lens of science and math and her uncertainty about the future.

The development/transition of Bel's relationship with Teo from antagonistic to friends to romantic is believable, sweet, and entertaining. It's life changing for Bel and Teo because it pushes them outside their comfort zones, challenging them. Having Teo believe she can do amazing things encourages Bel to take risks. But ultimately, Bel must believe in her own capabilities and realize she doesn't need Mateo to be strong, capable, confident, and successful. However, it's only one step on her road to success in STEM. Bel helps Teo grow as a person. Teo's a superior, egomaniac, who's dismissive, controlling, and unkind to people he views as beneath him-unworthy of his time-particularly Neelam and, at times, Bel. His relationship with Bel makes him question himself.

My Mechanical Romance is a sweet, engaging, enlightening, creative, funny, rivals-to-lovers/enemies-to-lovers YA romance.

In Jim Butcher's "Little Things," brave pixies in the service of wizard Harry Dresden protect his stronghold from evil, formidable goblins.

"The Dark Ship" by Anne Bishop is a dark fantasy with a scarred young woman who makes a selfless choice that garners her a favor from the leader of inhuman pirates.

In "Comfort Zone" by Kelley Armstrong, a young psychic and her werewolf boyfriend are recruited by a ghost to protect a loved one from human predators.

Annie Bellet's "Train to Last Hope" is the story of two estranged spouses who unite to find their long-lost child, using their magical skills in an Old West set adventure.

Kevin Hearne's "Fire Hazard" is from the point of view of druid Atticus O'Sullivan's devoted Irish Wolfhound Oberon, as they work to stop unnatural fires in the Australian wilderness.

"Grave Gambles" by R.R Virdi features a man whose unique ability to reanimate the body of a recent murder victim to solve the crime, on a case to find missing children.

"Silverspell" by Chloe Neill's latest story in the "Heirs of the Chicagoland Vampire" series involves a vampire sentinel and her werewolf boyfriend solving a series of ritual sacrifices of urban-dwelling supernaturals.

In "Troll Life" by Kerrie L. Hughes, Harzl is a troll who works an unglamorous job in an underground train system who intervenes to protect a gargoyle child from slavers.

Charlaine Harris' "The Return of the Mage" intertwines low fantasy and science fiction between warriors and mages who form an uneasy alliance to rescue the lost members of their battalion.

With "The Vampires Karamazov", Nancy Holder asks the reader to ponder how the famous Tolstoy novel would look if the family were all vampires.

In "The Necessity of Pragmatic Magic" by Jennifer Brozek, Maureen is a 71-year-old docent who may look mild-mannered, but she has some hidden skills to help protect her coworkers at the Stewart Historic Museum from a dangerous magical artifact.

Longtime fans of Asil the Old Wolf from Patricia Briggs' werewolf series have the privilege to accompany with him on a special kind of date that involves his unique set of skills in "Dating Terrors."

Heroic Hearts features the who's who of fantasy and sci-fi and has a little something for everyone in this wide variety of stories. It may involve some knowledge of the series to fully appreciate all the nuances, but even for new to the series readers, there are plenty of enjoyable moments. While a few of the stories were unimpactful, most showcase their writers' enviable skills at telling a short, satisfying, engrossing story. Overall, this is a recommended read for fantasy lovers.

So, Puerto Rican chef Kamilah Vega and Irish American whiskey distiller Liam Kane pretend to be engaged. Kamilah loves her family's Puerto Rican restaurant and believes the only way to save it in the wake of the gentrification of their Chicago neighborhood is to enter the Fall Foodie Tour. But first, she must convince her parents and family to go for her ideas, requiring them to change things at the restaurant. Unfortunately, her Abuelo won't let her change anything in his restaurant unless she marries the one man she can't stand: his best friend's grandson-her former best friend. After working to turn his family's distillery into a contender, Liam and his grandfather are close to winning a national competition with a prizewinning brew. Then, Liam's Grandpa reveals he has cancer, and his heart's set on Liam getting married to Kamilah ASAP. Their grandfathers threaten to sell the building housing the family businesses if they refuse to marry. So, Kamilah and Liam fake an engagement not expecting how complicated their entwined lives become.

Caña's use of language, colorful dialogue, vivid description, and cultural details sprinkled throughout her narrative make it a page turner. She smoothly blends Spanish into the dialogue with English. Caña wonderfully develops Kamilah and Liam's relationship, their sunshine heroine/grumpy hero dynamic, and the crackling and fiery tension sparked by their lifelong friendship

turned faux enemies. Liam and Kamilah's funny, snarky, sweet, intensely emotional, passionate, and chemistry-filled banter, interactions, and love scenes barely mask their underlying attraction/connection. Complete opposites, they complement and encourage each other to be their best. An incorrigible dreamer and optimistic force of nature, Kamilah is a bold, fearless, stubborn, and demanding social butterfly. Liam, on the other hand, is an antisocial loner and hermit burdened by past trauma and loss. Yet, he's also sensitive, sweet, caring, generous, supportive, loyal, and dependable.

Close familial bonds drive them to continue their family legacies. But Liam and Kamilah are burdened by family pressure and keeping secrets, preventing them from following their dreams and finding happiness and peace—also distancing themselves from loved ones. They have deep emotional ties still drawing them together despite their denial. Spending time with each other, living together, and pretending to be engaged while planning a wedding brings all those feelings to the surface.

A Proposal They Can't Refuse is a sweet, funny, steamy, angsty, entertaining family-centered, ex-friends-to-lovers, fake dating, and second chance romance about two friends finding their way back to each other, themselves, and their dreams.

University, she's hopeful that D.C. can be a safe harbor for her young daughter Trudy and herself after years on the run. If only Gemma could avoid the sexy and distracting philosophy professor Jethro, with whom she keeps crossing paths.

Jethro has blood on his hands from his time as a British Agent and a Deep Ops agent that he can never wash away, even though he now works in academia. He longs for redemption, nevertheless—something he believed beyond his reach until meeting Gemma and her daughter. Burdened by secrets and a tragic past, Gemma's wary of trusting and letting others into her life. Intelligent, handsome, charming, and sexy, Jethro presents a harmless, calm façade to the world. Gemma never expected to be swept away by passion again, but the chemistry between her and Jethro is fiery and intense–surprising both. Ultimately, protecting Gemma from a threat pursuing her requires Jethro to unleash the trained killer he's been trying to escape locked deep inside.

Zanetti dives directly into the story, weaving a suspenseful, eerie tale. *Unforgiven*'s scenes are vivid, lively, and detailed, especially the exhilarating action scenes and engaging character interactions, which are integral to the characters' development and Zanetti's complex, emotional, intense, and riveting story.
