

Dear QWERTY SWAG!



Dear Qwerty,

"What in the world is swag and why do I need it?" Books, Swag, and Goodies! Oh my! Readers love free stuff. They love special deals and discounts. They love meeting authors. But when an author gives them swag and goodies, they're in heaven!

Swag are goodies but with a slight difference. Many times they go into 'Swag Bags'. Honestly most of the time they're interchangeable. Swag can be anything small: pins, magnets, pens, business cards, and/or bookmarks. The list could go on!

Goodies are more targeted with a focus on the author's logo, quotes, and/or graphics: Books, coffee cups, glasses, plastic cups, pamphlets, notebooks, calendars, etc. Goodies are often given away during contests, at the author's table at book events, and/or on a Goodies Table.

They're all used for promotional purposes. It's the perfect advertisement for the author because readers love them!

If you're just starting out, I'd recommend going with bookmarks and pens. Start with one or the other. Both would be even better, but if you can't, that's okay.

Many hosts/hostesses will contact authors and request swag for their book event VIP swag bags. VIPs are readers who've paid extra for the book event. Even if you aren't attending the book event, find out how many swag items they'd need and send them on to the event coordinator. It will be worthwhile for you. It may or may not get you a book sale or two, however, it will get your name out there.

Name recognition: that's a good thing.

Let's talk about how to make your swag and goodies more advantageous.

Bookmarks and Business Cards: They don't always need to have your cover on them. But, if you've only got one



book out, put it on there. Make sure the dpi is 400 dpi or higher if it's a jpg. The reason why I say more than 300 dpi is because text tends to blur and that extra boost will make your bookmark have a crisper more professional appeal. Also, when you or your graphics artists saves it as a pdf, it'll compress to 300 dpi with no issues. Text shouldn't be any smaller than a 12pt font. Fonts should be easily legible. It's wonderful to have fancy, smancy lettering but it may make it difficult for the reader.

You can go with 300 dpi if it's a png. Pngs tend to adjust easier with press/print ready jobs.

The recommended dpi for the bookmarks works with almost all print/press ready goodies and swag.

*Some business cards can go down to 10pt font, but I wouldn't recommend it.

For the bookmark, use a short blurb very similar to the bullets publishers put on the front of book covers. If you can, include a QR code and your website address. For someone who only has one book, your card, or bookmark will have your cover, the blurb, your web address. If there's room a QR code, and perhaps whichever @yourname for social media.

As you move on to more than one book, I'd recommend using a universal background. Find something that's royalty free and not too distracting. Make sure the colors in the background are easy on the eyes, and easy to work with.

If you so choose, create a logo.

Once you've decided on a background that suits you, keep it consistent with the rest of your swag. So, any buttons, notebooks, magnets, etc, will have the same background, your quote, and website.

Coffee Cups, plastic cups, notebooks: For larger items the fonts and dpi need to also be at print/press ready. For example, if you decided to have coffee cups made up as goodies to give away to a contest recipient or at a book event, the images you choose, and text you use must be print/press ready. Depending on the size of the goodies will depend on how much text can be added along with the logo, or book covers.

I, personally, hand out note-books in a little bag with a bookmark, business card, and pen. There are several covers on the 5.5 x 8.5 notebook cover. At the top I have my blurb, *Stories That Stir Within Us the Unquenchable Hope for a Better Tomorrow*. At the bottom is PamelaAckerson.net. The text are at 14pt Garamond.

You no longer need to add www to any web addresses in text. It is automatic for any reader to know there's a www before your web address, regardless of whether it is a .com, .net, .org, .co, etc.

Have fun, and remember, readers love free swag and good




Love At The Twilight

Between the big secret Sadie is keeping, and the







AdC: Tell us about the genre(s) you write. Why did you choose to go in that direction?

TKL: I started writing paranormal romance because of my personal interest in paranormal phenomenon. I truly believe anything is possible and I write this in my books. Since I like the romance genre in general, and can't see myself really writing anything else, I decided to also dip my toe into contemporary romance, even venturing into writing a military romance novel for a charity to help pair Veterans with skilled K-9 companion.

AdC: Tell us about the type of characters you love to write about.

TKL: The characters in my contemporary romance stories are people with real issues. My curvy women often have been dumped, burned by past partners, and not so sure about the new men trying to vie for their attention. Curvy women who are strong, fiery and don't easily say yes make up most of my books, regardless if it's contemporary romance or paranormal.

For my paranormal books, I write primarily about two different

beings: angels and shape shifters of all kinds, including hybrids, which are my favorite. My angels are beautiful, strong, and protective. They are also kind and captivated by the females that capture their attention.







Gemma James loves helping women feel beautiful, and as the owner of Design Magic, she's living her dream every day. Helping women embrace fashion that flatters and fits is all the reward she needs, but her business limits her opportunities to meet a special man of her own.

While waiting to buy his sister a gift card, Anton Gates spots the well-loved stuffie by the cash register. But the moment he meets Gemma, he can tell she's the right person to help him find the perfect gift instead. Enchanted by Gemma's style and charm, it isn't long before Anton is envisioning the perfect little holiday gift for himself, too.

"Little Cakes" is a sweet and satisfying series, but dare to taste only if you like delicious Daddies, luscious Littles, and guaranteed happily-ever-afters. *Reindeer Tracks* is sweet as can be. Not so much a holiday story as a story taking place around the holidays. This is a wonderful addition to the series. Gemma gets to discover her Little side and Anton enjoys enlightening her. Each book in this series can be read standalone and I encourage you to take a bite. *D. Antonio*

Wright. Callum is the only person Raine thinks can help convince the Governor to stay her brother's execution. Raine offers Callum and his team a lead on a killer they are pursuing. However, she chooses to keep a fundamental secret from Callum. In a race against time, Callum and Raine work together to discover the truth before her brother dies and another man kills again.

From the moment her brother went to jail for murder, Raine devoted every moment of her life to proving his innocence. She even studied law and became a lawyer. Raine has no friends and no social life—only her job and the quest to get her brother off of death row and out of prison. Beautiful, loyal, intelligent, stubborn, and a proficient investigator, Raine gathers

and analyzes information that enables her to detect a serial killer that the police were unable to find.

A handsome former police detective who worked on the case upon which the murder conviction was based, Callum lacks technology skills and know-how and doesn't like lawyers. He works for a company that solves cold cases and helps law enforcement agencies without resources solve cases.

Diaz deftly develops her complex, relatable characters with emotional and snarky interactions that soften them. Her vivid descriptions draw readers in from the opening scenes and keep them turning the pages until the thrilling conclusion. She explores the criminal justice system and how prisoners on death row are treated with nuance, offering a different perspective on

the content from what readers may have read before.

Although the novel's primary focus is its well-developed suspense elements, Lena Diaz transitions Callum and Raine's relationship from an unlikely antagonistic partnership to a believable romance by the novel's end. *The Secrets She Keeps* is an intriguing, funny, intense, angsty, suspenseful, and emotional read.



In Meryl Wilsner's rom-com *Cleat Cute*, narrated by Dana Varden and Zim Avaltrades, Grace Henderson and Phoebe Matthews, U.S. Women's National Team soccer players, stumble into a friends-with-benefits relationship, never expecting to fall in love—while preparing for the World Cup.

Grace is a 10th-year U.S. Women's National Soccer Team star player. She's unprepared for an upstart rival—who excites and makes her feel alive—coming along to take her spot. When a hip injury sidelines Grace, Phoebe does just that. Phoebe can't believe she gets to train—possibly play—with her idol whose skill she's admired as long as she's loved soccer. Starstruck, Phoebe

sees Grace as more than her teammate, especially after they kiss. Unexpectedly, Grace and Phoebe become friends-with-benefits.

Grace's injury heals, and she and Phoebe discover how to play together as teammates instead of competing for her spot with the World Cup approaching. Their friends-with-benefits relationship is amazing. However, Phoebe thinks they're dating while Grace realizes she's catching feelings and doesn't know how to feel, believing Phoebe isn't serious about her. Will they discover their feelings/relationship is more important than the World Cup?

Wilsner deftly develops the relationships between diverse characters. Grace and Phoebe share an immediate connection. Wilsner captures fire and passion in their first kiss, then smoothly transitions their relationship from rivals to friends-with-benefits to two women falling in love who don't understand how they got there.

Narrators Avaltrades and Varden bring Wilsner's steamy and romantic novel to life. Avaltrades primarily narrates Grace's POV, and Varden Phoebe's, alternating for each other and secondary characters distinct voices, revealing their personalities, feelings,

quirks, and moods. Avaltrades' accents are excellent. Her lovely voice and expressive narration perfectly fit Grace's and other characters. Varden's narration for Phoebe makes her sound older than expected. But her pacing and inflection are spot-on for Phoebe's sunny, fast-talking personality. It's difficult imagining different narrators.

Complete opposites, they balance and help each other grow. Phoebe is extroverted, loud, and loves winning people over with laughter. However, she struggles with time management, quitting when things get hard, and lacking focus—except in soccer. Grace is an introvert who loves privacy and quiet. She's driven, wary, prefers control, plays with grit and perseverance, and isn't comfortable with feelings, relationships, or showing weakness. Grace is what Phoebe's been wanting/waiting for—judgment-free acceptance. Phoebe plays with excitement and joy that Grace doesn't remember losing.

Cleat Cute's excellently paced with a wonderful balance of steam, humor, angst, sexiness, pining, and sports. Wilsner's lively and colorful dialogue, vivid description, and engaging interactions between complex, fallible, and likable characters make it a captivating, fast-paced, multi-layered romance. 

Out There Screaming is an anthology of horror short stories written by black authors. Edited by renowned film director Jordan Peel, nineteen stories explore the wide and deep spectrum of horror. The appeal of this anthology is just how varied each story is in subject matter. While "horrors" of the black experience, ranging from "superficially" subtle to structural and up to overt and violent racial terror is a common theme, there is so much nuance to the subject matter. Hatred of others is like a monster in itself, making its targets feel helpless at being able to protect themselves or fight back, but some of the stories remind the reader that there are dark and unknown creatures in the world that are indifferent to the concerns of humanity.

The intersection of the historical and contemporary experiences of people of the Black Diaspora is explored richly and darkly. The variety of stories also shows that while the Diaspora share a Sub-Saharan black African ancestry, there is so much diversity in the individual cultures and experiences of its members. A few of the stories deal with folklore and legends, which is this reader's favorite kind of horror/scary genre. Lessons taught and passed down from one generation to the next aid the current generation in evading dark fates, and in some cases, creatures of myth awake to protect those of that heritage from the real life horrors of racist violence against their community. Science fiction horror is also well-represented in this collection. Some of the stories are quite opaque in meaning and very bizarre. Their subject matter is not easily categorized or explained in any way. Readers who enjoy the just plain weird --and value asking themselves, "What did I just read?"--will also find something appealing here.

Without calling out specific authors over others, there are some very talented writers in this collection, and each story is worth reading for the experience. Readers who consider themselves horror fans who enjoy quality, thoughtful writing, and in particular want to explore the black experience in their horror, should definitely check out this collection.

Kushiel's Dart introduced the world of Terre d'Ange and a young courtesan named Phèdre, who was chosen by Namaah to serve in pleasure and pain. Joscelin was the bodyguard who becomes her companion as Phèdre becomes the only person who can save her country from treachery. Now, it's time to see the story through Joscelin's eyes.

In Terre D' Ange, the people follow the faith of Elua, the son of Jesus, born when His blood was shed at Calvary, and His angelic companions. Joscelin Verreuil is the middle son of his noble family, sworn to serve in the Casseline Brotherhood, dedicated to Cassiel, the Perfect Companion. He is taken from his family to start his training at ten years old. The book spans those ten years, showing the cost of Joscelin's vows and what shapes him into the man he is when he meets

Phèdre. When he is selected to be Phèdre's protector, it's far from what he desired. Their values seem absolutely contradictory in many ways. However, an act of betrayal puts them in mortal danger and terrible hardship, an experience that binds the pair together in a way that's deeper than the skin.

Cassiel's Servant is a still an epic read, despite its much shorter length than Kushiel's Dart. Joscelin, an enigmatic, highly romantic, larger than life figure in the previous book, is even more appealing when the story unfolds through his eyes. He struggles with his vows to serve Cassiel (through celibacy) and by upholding his vow to protect and serve his charge even up to death. As he grows to love Phèdre, that vow changes and blooms like a flowering tree. He grows from a young man whose narrow view of the world initially and narrowly shaped his values to an increased understanding of human nature and the complexities of emotion, from sexual desire, familial love, and the desire to serve one's country even at the cost of self-sacrifice. Joscelin's fighting skills are beautifully depicted, as he demonstrates the time
