We all have positive and negative life experiences. As writers, what we know isn't as important as how we tell it and express it. Keep in mind that when you write, the reader wants to join you in the adventure.

Take them with you with every turn of the page.



Kingsley, the Artic Wolf, refuses to walk away. But witches and wolves? They don't mix. Or do they?



K-9 heroes joined the fun. Gift baskets were raffled off, and there was an auction at the end of the day to benefit the Georgia Police K-9 Foundation.







Cover Model Corner with *Billy Freida by Debra Parmley*



Today I'm excited to interview Billy Freida. I first met Billy at a *Romantic Times* Booklovers convention several years ago, and it's fun to catch up with him today. Billy is a model/TV host/comic/actor who began his career in print and commercial, appearing on almost 250 book covers and countless magazines and commercials. Billy graduated with a degree in engineering from Rutgers University, but quickly left the field after graduation when he booked his first commercial audition ever, a national commercial for IBM. Billy has since added theater, stand up, voice over and several independent films and TV shows to his credits.

Debra: *Billy, what was the first cover you appeared on and how did this come about?*

Billy: My very first cover was *Heart of Vengeance* by Tracy Cooper-Posey. It was part of my package for winning the national cover model competition.

Debra: *If you could do a photo shoot anywhere in the world for a cover, where would you most want to go? What sort of shoot*



would it be?

Billy: Well, I have shot calendars and commercials in exotic places, but I would definitely love to do a cover shoot in Fiji, but for a series. A lot of authors want to know if their story is going to be told over several books, therefore, I'd love to do several different cover shoot scenes in Fiji and then have different pictures for each cover as the series evolves.

Debra: *Beyond romance novel cover shots, what other projects or jobs keep you busy?*

Billy: 74 Red Carpet credentials
28 IMDB film and television credits
7 calendars
4 Magazine Covers
Countless commercial and print ads
TV host and comic as well.

Debra: *What's one question you wish an interviewer would ask you?*

Billy: What's your IQ?

Debra: *If you wrote a book, what would it be about?*

Billy: Well, I'm actually writing a book and a screen play. The book will be called *If These Credentials Could Talk*, and it's a non-fiction book about all the red carpets I've been on, celebrity events/award shows I've attended and my interactions with celebrities. The screen play (w/o violating my NDA) is a full-length film about a research lab that discovers a biological gene, that can change history moving forward but is it ethical and moral to do so.

Debra: *I'm intrigued by both projects and looking forward to reading and seeing them. This question is almost always asked in interviews because*

your fitness level is beyond the average persons. What is your exercise routine and what sort of nutrition plan do you follow to achieve and maintain your level of fitness?

Billy: On, over the last 13 years I average a little over 4 days a week in the gym. However, that's because I'm in maintenance mode, and just want to keep what I have. Prior to 2012 I was probably averaging closer to 5.5 days a week in the gym. As for nutrition, that is an answer that's different for everyone, depending on a lot of factors. That is a question that is better answered in a live setting, as it's quite complex.

Debra: *If you could share three simple fitness tips the average romance reader could do to stay healthy, what would they be?*

Billy: 1) Ounces are lost in the gym, pounds are lost at the table.
2) You have to want a healthy lifestyle for YOU. Whatever your motivation, you have to want to do it.

3) Being healthy and health conscience is not just for aesthetic reasons, more importantly it's for health reasons. So many health issues and diseases can be avoided or reversed by a healthy lifestyle. Be healthy for the loved ones you want to be around for longer

Debra: *Good advice. Now it's your birthday dinner and the calories don't count. What's on the menu and what are you drinking?*

Billy: Oh dear! Well, it couldn't be the Italian Christmas Eve 7 fish dinner, because my birthday is in August, so it would have to be sushi, as I absolutely love it. so I would have to say unlimited sushi. But be careful if you take me out for that, I'm not a cheap date lol. Drinks would have to be a few New Zealand *Sav Blancs* finished off with a large peaty scotch!

Debra: *That Christmas Eve dinner sounds wonderful, and sushi is fun to eat!*

Describe the perfect romantic evening:

Billy: Please, too cliché. There's not a man on the planet that answers this honestly. (Sorry, that's the comic in me)

Debra: *Now you've made me laugh! Okay, please share three unusual facts about you or your life:*

Billy: 1) I have no first cousins.

2) I have an engineering degree even though I'm an actor/model/comic.

3) I have red ear syndrome (Very rare, look it up lol)







and in wondering if Rebecca and Matthew can face their demons strongly enough to let them find love. The ending is delightful with a twist it's difficult to anticipate.





Forever Theirs is recommended for readers into relationship-focused, steamy reads about throuple/poly relationships with some suspense. Writing in her protagonists' first-person POVs, Mitchell dives into Aspen, Aiden, and Miles' emotions to explore the instant attraction, development of the poly/throuple relationship, and evolution of their characters, which becomes a healing, emotional, and sexual journey. Their snarky banter and sexy, steamy interactions and love scenes reveal and evolve their characters, furthering the novel's plot. Mitchell's complex relationships, well-constructed action/fight scenes, and gripping suspense keep readers on the edge of their seats. Her straight-to-the-point narrative style, vibrant descriptive writing, and world-building make readers feel they're in each moment with the characters.

Mitchell focuses on developing their intimacy and connection. The pacing is moderate, with a greater focus on romance/sexual relationships than suspense. *Forever Theirs* begins with a dark, suspenseful opening, only then to be barely explored and mentioned off and on, with brief mentions of a missing friend, leaving readers wondering what's going on, and minimizing the sense of urgency. While the suspense and romance could be more balanced, *Forever Theirs* is a sweet, steamy, funny, sexy, and intriguing start to Mitchell's new romantic suspense series.

Cleo's twin brother went missing while working for Cyrus. She takes a job bar tending at Cyrus' bar, in exchange for a place to stay and his help.

Trusting and innocent, Cleo doesn't believe in magic and fate. She's stubborn and impudent—just what self-absorbed, superior, bossy gods need. She is also strong and fearless, and unwilling to give up, even when she has no way out of her circumstances, even up against gods.

Cyrus blows hot and cold with Cleo because he knows what his duty is, but he's deeply drawn to her and wants to keep Cleo with him. He feels guilty about what he must do. For the first time in so long, he's aroused—by a chaos descendant. Tortured, self-controlled, and lonely, he's never slept with a human before. All these years trapped on Earth, he's become cruel and torn between his duty and desire for her. The other 12 gods have failed. He cannot. Readers will love Cleo and how she doesn't always do what Cyrus wants and stands up to him and the other gods. Van Dyken sets Cleo and Cyrus up as two opposites who pair and balance each other well. Cleo is always cold, while Cyrus gives off heat. Cyrus is drawn to her while driven by duty while her life is all about sacrifice. Cleo and Cyrus' hilarious, snarky banter and sex intimate interactions and love scenes are well written, revealing and evolving their characters and furthering the novel's plot. Van Dyken's well-constructed action scenes and gripping suspense keep readers on the edge of their seat. More of these scenes would've been

better throughout the novel.

Immortal Sun's mellow pacing and unexpected mix of dark humor and suspense works for Van Dyken's story. Cleo and Cyrus' romance could've been developed more in depth earlier in the novel, as things get interesting, intense, and the attraction they share gets explored well into the novel. It may be more fantasy romance than romantasy as the fantasy elements are more developed than the romance. Van Dyken's active, straight-to-the-point writing/narrative style, language use, colorful dialogue, fascinating characters, intriguing mythology, and superb world-building draws readers in immediately, keeping your interest despite the pacing.

A Murderer Among Us is a cozy mystery that shows life and romance don't end when someone reaches retirement age. It sheds a little light on the culture of retirement communities, and even though it exposes some people with evil intentions, it does so with touches of humor.
