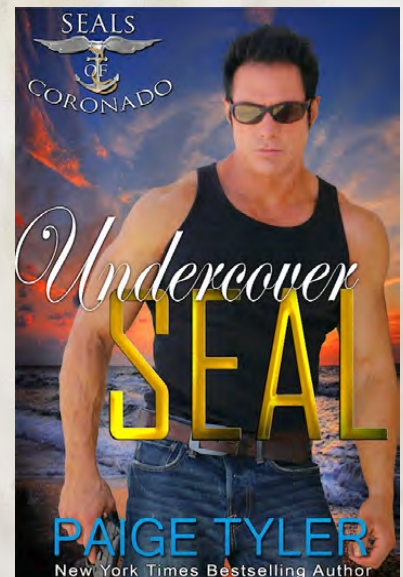

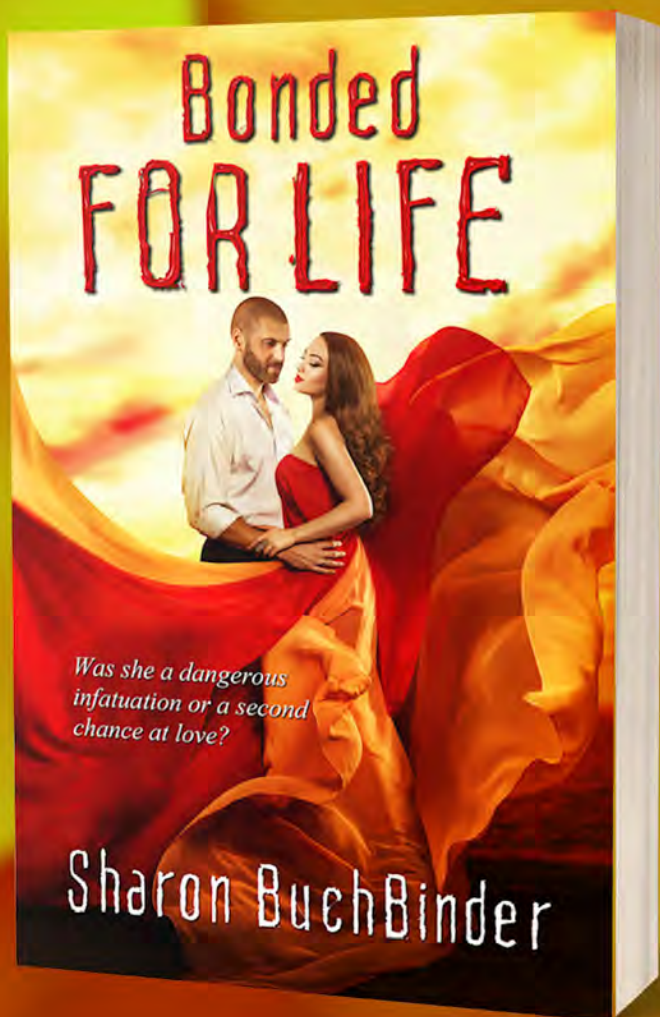

## Neuro Marketing

What is Neuro-marketing?



Neuro—the medical term means nerves or the nervous system.

Neurodiversity has to do with brain functions that affect mental function.

Neuroscience studies the brain.

Consumer neuroscience studies the brain on how to manipulate consumer behavior.

Marketers have coined the term neuro-marketing, which is the same as consumer neuroscience.

Easy right? So how do we, as authors, take those techniques and use them to our advantage? Brain triggers. Marketing tips using the old brain triggers can be challenging. Emotions, along with a little bit of logical reasoning prompts readers to buy. Targeting those emotions will trigger and encourage them to purchase the product.

In other words, use psychology and the emotions that go with it. For years, experts have taken the neurosciences to influence consumers and snag those subconscious and emotional thoughts. They've studied the behavior of consumers and learned what makes them tick.

The cute dog or cat, racing to the bowl of the

most delicious food.

And my favorite, Haribo gummies, taking adults back to the time when they were kids and had fun with snacks. I don't think I've met anyone who didn't like those commercials.

The Busch Clydesdale commercials all incite that feel good smile and it makes the brain associate feeling good with the product.

How can you improve your marketing and advertising? Answer the following questions.

How do I reach readers? Name recognition.

Whom do I want to purchase my books? Determine your audience.

What do the readers want? Emotion. They want to feel, each one will want to feel different things for different reasons.

How can I be more effective in my marketing? Pay attention to what's going on.

Did you get clicks but no or low purchases? You were able to grasp their interest, but what happened?

Why didn't they click the purchase button? Did you continue to trigger their interest?

Did you reach the right audience? Targeting the proper consumer will avoid wasting time and money.

Craft the advertisement to evoke emotions. Once they hit the landing page to purchase, don't stop there.

You must give a compelling description that leaves them wanting more.

Using neuro-marketing will increase your advertising effectiveness. It's a given. Watch how the big guys do it. They like using numbers. It brings order to chaos. Odd numbers inspires thought and for some reason, the number three seems to be something our brains latch onto. Even numbers are more positive. (Pun intended.) They're friendlier, couples, even numbered friends all bring about happiness.

Amazon...the arrow looks like a smile. The largest consumer store in the US utilizes neuroscience when they advertise. You should, too.

Determine the emotions you want your reader to have and take advantage of that. And you can certainly use both even and odd numbers. Test it out; see which one works better for the goals you want to achieve.

Another suggestion, especially if it's a website ad, is to keep it short and sweet by inciting their curiosity. Some readers scan text quickly and certain keywords will grab their attention. If you have what they're looking for, they'll click.

Using powerful words to describe your story can create a positive emotional trigger for readers. Words

**AdC:** *Where and when would you travel to if you were given a time*



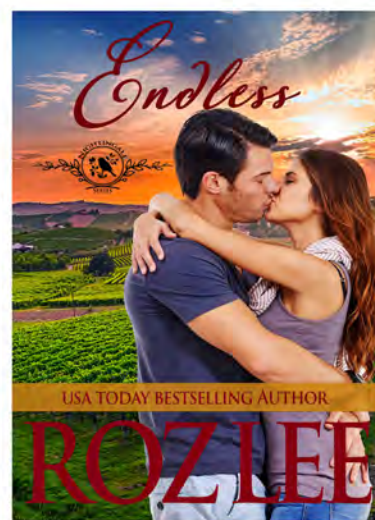
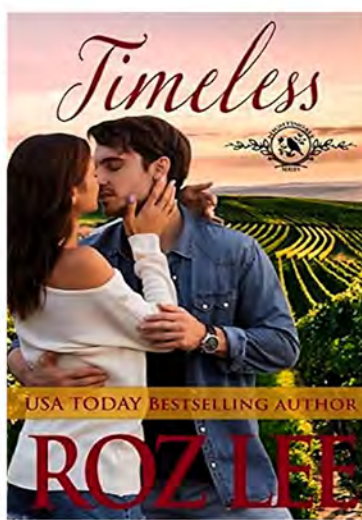

# Cover Model Corner with *Julian Christian by Debra Parmley*



**Debra:** Today I'm excited to interview cover model and author, Julian Christian. Welcome Julian! What was the first cover you appeared on and how did this come about?

**Julian:** First off, thank you for having me. Let's see it was many moons ago, but I believe it was a fitness magazine called *Men's Exercise*. I think the first book cover called *Close Quarters* where I was a Marine.

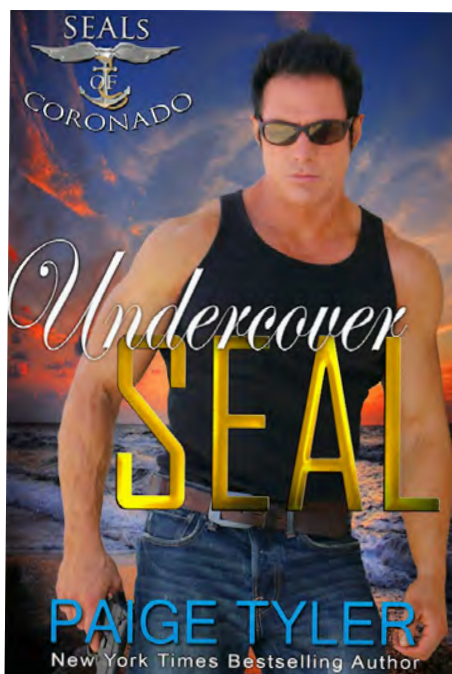
**Debra:** You're welcome. Now if you could do a photo shoot anywhere in the world for a cover, where would you most want to go? What sort of shoot would it be?

**Julian:** So many places, how do I choose? It would definitely be some place historical like the Coliseum in Rome or the Acropolis in Athens.

**Debra:** Beyond romance novel cover shoots, what other projects or jobs keep you busy?

**Julian:** I don't model anymore these days. I keep busy with my





career in pediatrics, my animals, and I started writing. Just published my first novel.

**Debra:** *You have accomplished a lot! I want to chat about your book in a minute. What's one question you wish an interviewer would ask you?*

**Julian:** Do I like tacos? The answer is YES! Kidding, of course. I would love to be asked about my spirituality. It's something I've been working on for a while.

**Debra:** *Now I'm hungry for tacos! Lol I always ask this question - If you wrote a book, what would it be about? Tell us about it.*

**Julian:** Well, I did write a book, it's a dystopian novel about AI controlling humanity. I think it's pretty good and I hope people will enjoy it.

**Debra:** *This question is almost always asked in interviews because your fitness level is beyond the average persons'. What is your exercise routine and what sort of nutrition plan do you follow to achieve and maintain your level of fitness?*

**Julian:** Mix of weight training and cardio, but the key is to be consistent. Make fitness apart of your life and it will take care of you. My diet is mostly plant based with some wild caught fish and organic eggs thrown in. I try to eat mostly organic. Lots of whole grains, vegetables, and fruit. I don't touch dairy or meat.

**Debra:** *If you could share three simple fitness tips the average romance reader*

*could do every day to stay healthy, what would they be?*

**Julian:** Walking for one. It's low impact and we are built to walk. Another would be stretching. It's important to maintain our flexibility as we get older. Third would be to do some lite weight training. It's important to maintain muscle mass as we get older.

**Debra:** *Excellent advice. Now it's your birthday dinner and the calories don't count. What's on the menu and what are you drinking?*

**Julian:** Sushi from Nobu! And some vegan deserts. I don't drink alcohol so I would just go with a matcha latte.

**Debra:** *Describe the perfect romantic evening.*

**Julian:** The evening begins as the sun starts to set, painting the sky in warm hues of gold and pink. Soft music drifts through the air as candles flicker to life, creating an intimate atmosphere in a carefully prepared space. 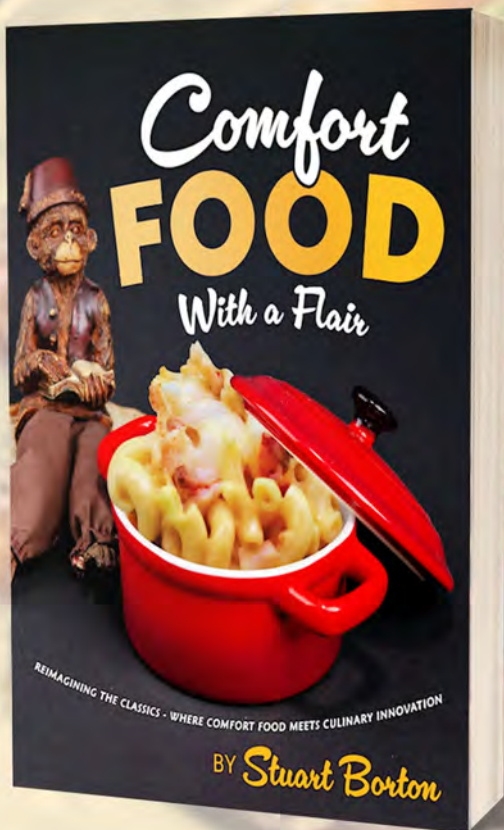

If it's a good story, she'll write it, no matter where it seems to fit! She's a hopeless romantic and always will be. Risking it all for Happily Ever After is what she lives by!*

*She's originally from Ohio but got to Texas as soon as she could. She's happily married and has a bachelor's degree in criminal justice. She's always writing, and helps small business owners by writing their websites, and she loves it!"*

**AdC:** *Do you have a new book or series?*

**C.S.:** I do have a fun project that I released in November of 2024 and what I did was go back to the first book of this series, *Sword's Call*. And I worked with an illustrator and an artist, and we put out a big book. It is 8 1/2 by 11 in hardcover, and we did 24 full-color illustrations plus the formatter did some really cool chapter openers. So it's the same story, but fully illustrated, including the naughty bits, which I always giggle at when I say it out loud. It turned out really beautiful and I love it. Eventually I will go back and do the others.

**AdC:** *If you were transported to the setting of the book you're currently reading or writing, where would you be?*

**C.S.:** Ohh, that would be completely fun! I am working in my fantasy world that I created so I would be there with my characters in my six provinces. With magic and wolves and dragons, etcetera!

**AdC:** *How do you name your characters?*

**C.S.** Strangely enough, my characters usually "introduce" themselves to me. So I don't really name them. I usually think of what I want to write about, or a character pops into my mind and tells me that they have a story. That's usually how it goes for me. Generally, when I know a character's name, that's what it is. Even if I don't like it.

**AdC:** *What part of the book was the most fun to write?*

**C.S.:** The intimacy scenes. Sometimes I even start with them, even if they're not at the beginning of the book. (Because normally they're not at the beginning of the book, of course!) But I love the chase part of the romance. I like to see them in bed together so I can see how they got there.

**AdC:** *Where and when would you travel to if you were given a time machine?*

**C.S.:** Scotland, the Isle of Skye. In my second series that I have going, I'm writing about the 17th century and of course being a woman then, even a strong woman, wasn't really awesome, lol! Libraries and reading became Selene and her siblings' escape, but Selene has a weakness for bad boys—especially with horns.

Sam is driven by the need for vengeance. His moods are volatile and dangerous. Kidnapped from the underworld as a child and abandoned in Aurelia, he longs to return home. He's intensely drawn to Selene, believing she may be his fated mate. The only demon in the kingdom, he is feared by all because of his scars. He feels like an outcast in Aurelia and is often lonely.

Aileen Bishop's dynamic narration complements Griffin's down-to-earth, fast-paced, descriptive writing and multi-layered, steamy urban mythology-like novel. Bishop's flair for narrating a cast of humans, demons, vampires, fae, cryptids, and other immortal creatures of varied genders and ages immediately draws and awes

readers. Before they know it, the audiobook's over. However, it's a nice change of pace that Sam's voice isn't the typical gruff, aggressive one of most demonic heroes.

Griffin's mythology is intriguing, and her characters are fascinating. She develops Selene and Sam's characters, their relationship with each other, and their scenes with vivid and detailed descriptions. Selene and Sam's love scenes are funny, steamy, and sweet while they contribute to the evolution of their connection, characters, and the story.

Suspenseful, funny, and steamy, *Unbound by Shadows* is a fast-paced start to Griffin's fated-mates "Shadows of Aurelia" series.

Dakota and Sidney are two younger teenage best friends who enjoy spending time together and exploring the Washington state forests near their homes. Dakota wants to ask Sidney to be his girlfriend before he and his mom leave for a trip to the beach, but a series of events

complicates that plan, including an encounter with a real Bigfoot, a sasquatch named River on his own unique quest, family troubles for both friends, and discovering a decades' old mystery.

*Serenade of the Sasquatch* is a coming-of-age story that explores the difficult situations that young teens face on the cusp of growing up. The inclusion of Bigfoot's point of view is odd initially, but it is an intrinsic aspect of the story. Descriptive prose of the wilderness vividly sets the scene. The use of a journal from twenty years ago is a very good narrative device that ties the contemporary point of view to the past mystery. The mystery is set up very well, with a satisfying resolution. Notes of humor mix well with pathos from realistic family drama and issues, including missing loved ones, alcoholic parents, parental abuse, and a lack of understanding extended from overwhelmed parents to their children.

There is a subtle Christian element that feels natural to the plot, in which faith is something that guides characters and helps them through difficult times, and not a weapon used against others. This book isn't for everyone, but *Serenade of the Sasquatch* is a quirky, fun, but emotionally impactful young adult book with a unique storyline worth checking out.

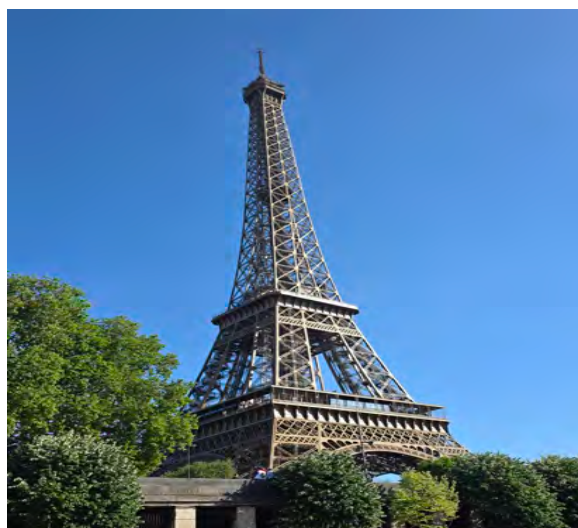
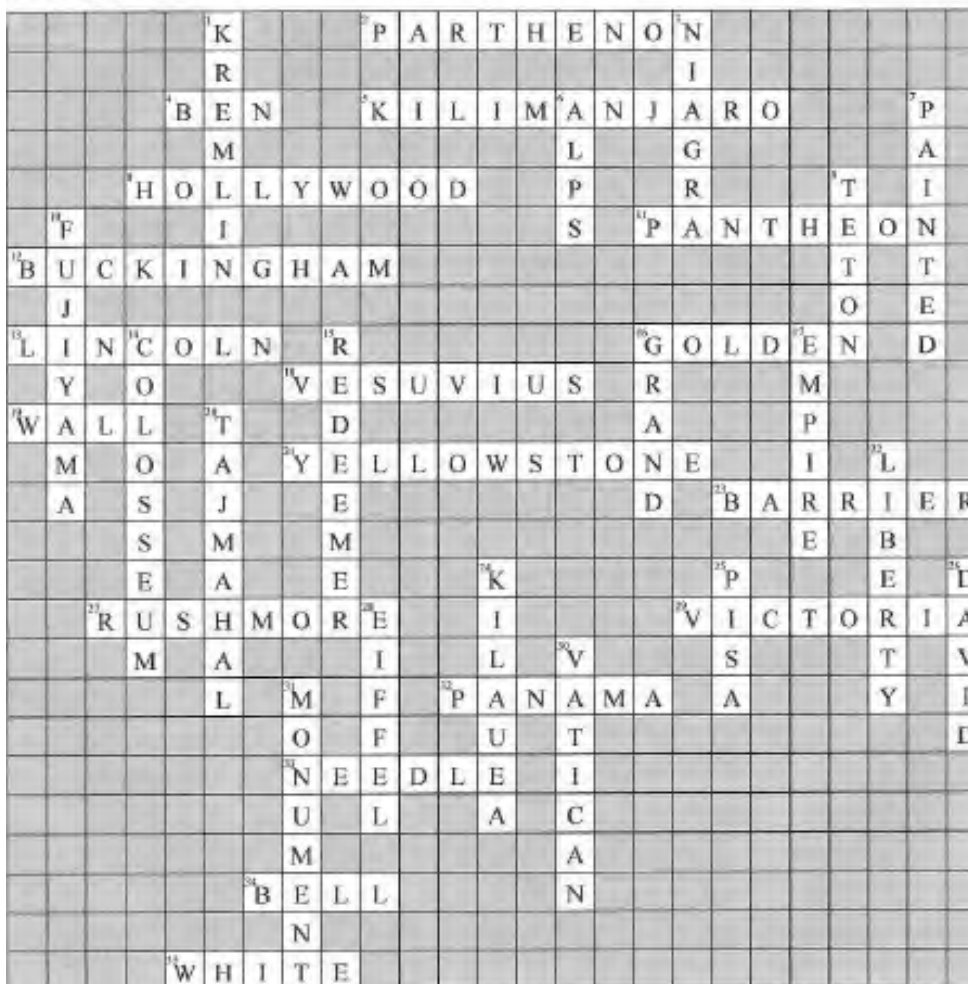
