Beware! The New Way to Scam!

"experts" in advertising that it has pretty much become a household joke.

One of the warnings I tell authors is, if someone claims to be an expert in advertising---run, run away as fast as you can.

There's no such thing. What worked yesterday may not work today. What works with promoting books changes faster than the waves pounding on a beach during a hurricane.


Don't get me wrong. I'm not completely against the use of AI. It can really help sometimes, give authors a little nudge, and help their brain go into second gear. It can kick in that creativity needed to move forward.

But not for doing all the work!

These scammers use AI to write their promotions. It's obvious to me but may not be for someone who isn't accustomed to the way things are written and promoted. They're extremely convincing. By using all those marketing keywords, it makes them sound like they know what they're talking about.

Readers only read the first few reviews on the Amazon or Goodreads page, if they read them at all. Don't let the scammers make you feel bad because you only have 3 or 5, or 10 reviews. Yes, reviews help with Amazon's algorithm. But, so does clicks to the page, interest by readers, consistent sales, and/or bookmarking an author's page, etc.

The most ironic/comical one for me is promising hundreds of reviews: Send

your doc, .docx, or pdf and for a small fee they'll send it to all the 2000 reviewers they have lined up to review your book.

Nooooooooooo! No, no, no. Never send your .doc or .docx! This is how they steal your story, send it to pirate sites, or harvest your book to other authors who will plagiarize the book and put it in their name.

Only send your pdf, if you know 100% that they are a legitimate business.

Authors need to answer their emails and these scammers know it. We can't take the chance of ignoring a legitimate reader, thinking they might be a scammer. However, AI has created a way for scammers to pretend they've read your book, hook you into believing they're genuine about liking your book, and then hit you with a marketing promotion scheme. If you pay attention

to how it's written, it's practically word for word. They use AI which knows exactly what to say and how to say it to make you convinced the person sending you the email is legitimate.

Be careful answering the email. I swear they're like those irritating telemarketers. "We got a response!" And then, now you have twenty emails you have to answer because you can't ignore a potential reader.

If you choose to answer the email, ask questions. What's your website? What are your rates? How long have you been in business? How long have you been with the company?

Do a google search before you click on the link!

Make sure the link they give you and the website address match. Make sure it has that little lock up near the web address. What does their website look like? Do they have an address and phone number listed?

The biggest warning is when they have no website and use a Gmail account, or some other random account that isn't associated with a business .com or .net. If they do have a website but there's no prices on the pages move on. Sorry, but if you can't put your rates on your page you're either too expensive for me or are a scammer just trying to take my money.

Oh, and the phone calls. What I want to know is how they got my number! I've never given them my phone number. And please don't give them your number, they're trained well to scam you.

Here's a little taste of what to expect in Book One of the "Brigade Trucking Company":



AdC: If you were transported to the setting of the book you're currently reading or writing, where would you be?

AdC: How do you name your characters?

TKL: Most of the time the names just come to me. Yes, I know, it's crazy like that. For the female characters in my first few books, I actually used the names my mom had considered naming me but didn't. I liked the names and thought it would be neat to have them in books. I prefer unusual, different names to the more common ones, so you may find some pretty unique names in my stories and/or unique spellings. Lately, I have been using search engines to find some unique names when I can't think of anything.

AdC: What part of the book was the most fun to write?

TKL: For my current work-in-progress, the most fun part of the book I wrote was probably the most controversial part. Besides the beginning of the

book where I introduced the characters, I did enjoy writing a part of the book that I am not sure if readers will like; however, it just goes with the nature of "The Brigade" and what is expected, so I had to leave it in there. I am known for playing with concepts and stretching the line, so I hope my readers will love what I did and still like me (heehee).

AdC: Where and when would you travel to if you were given a time machine?

TLK: Actually, I like living in modern times. Yet, if I had the opportunity to visit a time in the past or future, I might want to check out how it was living in Victorian England. I have always had a fascination with all things Victorian, including cameos, and even though I have no love for the way women were treated during that time or what they were made to wear (corsets), I would still love to visit and see the landscape and the elaborate carriages and balls they used to attend. Then I'd travel right on back to modern times where we have wonderful air conditioning.

AdC: What do you do when you can't quite get into writing mode?

TLK: Actually, this has happened quite a lot lately as my day job has become increasingly stressful and there has been added pressure to perform. I have been slacking and taking time off, just because I need that extra time to rest and decompress. I like to go out and experience things. Going to some place new or visiting a new place with a friend always brings the joy back into my life, so I try to do this when I can. It also helps to engage an author with new and fresh ideas if they are lacking some/have writer's block.

AdC: What traditions do you believe should be brought back?

TLK: Not putting up holiday displays until the month before the holiday. Haha. Yeah, I think we are rushing

through the year too fast anymore and I would like to not see Christmas displays out in August... I just want to enjoy the month I am in because it won't come around again.

AdC: What do you like to do when it's time to kick back?

TLK: Spend time with my hubby. I truly married my best friend so many years ago. We love spending time together and you will likely see him at any of my events as my "forced PA." Lol. I joke about this, but he actually likes helping me out. He believes in me and supports me, which I know is a blessing because not all authors get this backing from their significant others.

Spending quality time together is what we like doing best and that can be doing anything. It could be something as simple as watching TV together to going to an elaborate party together, all dressed up.

AdC: Is there something you've always wanted to learn to do?

TKL: I would love to be able to paint, but, sadly, I have no talent for it. I am in awe of those who can just whip up something from their imagination and it actually looks like what they intended it to be. I stare in fascination at gorgeous paintings, and I have always been thrilled with artwork, but, sadly, that artistic talent escaped me.

AdC: Will you be attending any book signings or conventions?

TKL: Always (wide smile). For the rest of the year, I am at Ocala Comic-Con, Orlando Reads Books and at White Rose Books for a book signing in December.


The day had only started, and it seemed to grow longer by the minute. Yet this time, it wasn't all his fault.

She was a rare find for his kind. She was some-




one he thought he would never find in his lifetime. Yet here she was, tempting and teasing him and frustrating him with her lack of awareness.




An Interview with Cover Model Charles LeMar Brown











.P.: Today I'm pleased to be interviewing Charles Lemar Brown in Cover Model Corner.

What was the first cover you appeared on and how did it come about?

CLB: The first cover I appeared on was a novel by Tina Susedik – *Picturing Annabella* (from her "The Darlings of Deadwood" series).

D.P.: If you could do a photo shoot anywhere in the world for a cover, where would you most want to go? What sort of shoot would it be?

CLB: I would love to do a photo shoot in Monument Valley, Arizona. It would be a wonderful place to do both historical and contemporary western/cowboy images.

D.P.: Yes, it would. Beyond romance novel cover shots, what other projects keep you busy?

CLB: Before I became a cover model, I was already a part of the book world. Both my mother and father were published authors, and I had dabbled in both prose and poetry for years. After some rather persistent pushing from my mother, I finished my first novel in 2022. In 2023, I published *The Road to Nowhere* and have since completed six additional works. When not modeling, I am either writing or traveling to a book conference with my family.

D.P.: I'm glad your mother pushed you to publish. Now readers can look for your books. Wild Deadwood Reads in South Dakota is where I first met you. Now, what's one question you wish an interviewer would ask?

CLB: Do you believe in love at first sight? In true love? Did you always believe this way or did some event in your life change the way you felt about love?

D.P.: Those are good questions! If you wrote a book, what would it be about?

CLB: When you are blessed with ADHD, as I am, often what you write depends a lot on the squirrels (that is how I choose to refer to the ever changing, ever random, thoughts that run through my brain). I mostly write poetry but have published three novels in the Family Life Fiction Genre and two collections of rural humor short stories. I am currently working on a small-town thriller/murder mystery.

D.P.: I'll be watching for that, as I love a good murder mystery. Your fitness level is beyond the average person's. What is your exercise routine and what sort of nutrition plan do you follow to achieve and maintain your level of fitness?


CLB: To stay fit, I spend thirty minutes every morning on a stationary bicycle and about an hour Monday through Saturday lifting free weights. I don't have a set nutritional plan, but most of the time I maintain a high protein, low carbohydrate, and low sugar lifestyle.

D.P.: If you could share three simple fitness tips the average romance reader could do every day to stay healthy, what would they be?
CLB:

- 1. Mind, Body, & Spirit: It's important to remember that there is more to fitness than just the body. It is just as important to keep the mind and spirit healthy.
- 2. Stay active: Inactivity is the new smoking. A slow walk around the house is better than sitting around all day.
- 3. Limit your sugar intake: Sugar is very addictive, and it feeds so many of the diseases that plague our bodies.

D.P.: Excellent advice. Now it's your birthday dinner and calories don't count. What's on the menu and what are you drinking?

CLB: A twelve-ounce K.C. Strip steak cooked medium-rare, a loaded baked potato, a side of mac-and-cheese, hot rolls (several), and a half gallon of southern



sweet tea (which means it has at least two cups of sugar per gallon). And for dessert, a chocolate tuxedo cheesecake.

D.P. Delicious. Describe the perfect romantic evening.

CLB: Whether it's a single red rose or a bouquet of daisies, the perfect romantic evening should start with flowers, followed by a candlelit dinner with soft music playing in the background. After which, a stroll on the beach that leads to a slow dance to the music of the ocean waves.

Her journey into writing began when she helped her



Fifteen million books sold? That's a fire hazard in paperback form. You're out here saving damsels, handing them yachts, and probably a coupon for couples therapy. In a world of AI fanfic and TikTok thirst traps, you're the fairy godmother of escapism, waving a pen instead of a wand.

But please, Kat, next book, can the villain stay evil? My bookshelf's begging for a plot twist that doesn't end in a redemption arc and a sunset make-out. Keep slaying, you absolute legend—just don't make me read about another "tortured earl" with a heart of gold.





He has nothing but disdain for Tess because she's impulsive, clumsy, and messy, and his attitude does nothing for her already deep insecurity.

During one of their skirmishes, they trip into a puddle where an electric heater falls into the water, and with a zap of electricity, they find themselves transported 200 years into the past—to Jane Austen's time. On a personal level Eve Dallas is mellowing a bit more with each book in the "Death" series by J.D. Rob. The hard-boiled detective is happily married to Roark and has made friends with a number of her co-workers.

But Eve Dallas has not softened her approach to the criminals she brings to justice. The serial killer she is investigating fancies himself an artist. His bizarre approach to art involves approaching "licensed companions" who work on the street and luring them to his loft, where he first flatters them about being the perfect model for his paintings, and then drugs them, kills them, and uses them as carefully posed props for his work.

His paintings are duplicates of a collection of old masters' work,

including "Vermeer's Girl With a Pearl Earring" and Gainsborough's "The Blue Boy." He meticulously recreates the poses and costumes depicted in the paintings. Once he's done, he leaves the bodies, still carefully posed, at the doorsteps of several art dealers who rejected his work.

Dallas, Roark, and the crew race against time, certain he intends to continue his killing spree to feed his artistic aspirations. Though they warn the streetwalkers of the danger, the lure of a quick \$2,000 with more to come proves too good to pass up for some, who don't realize their mistake until it is too late.

Framed in Death contains a bit more social interaction than some of the other Dallas novels, with parties and housewarmings and the like. Eve still relies on Roark to give wardrobe advice and to remind her to eat. His computer skills and connections also prove invaluable in speeding up solving the case.

The unique delusions of the serial killer become apparent to Dallas fairly quickly, but the hunt for him

before he captures his next victim provides some nail-biting suspense.

Clio Louise Barnes has an enviable life. She is a successful social media influencer and stylist, living a glamorous life in New York City, and she has a close family made up of two sisters and her father. But her past soon catches up with her when her estranged mother passes away and she goes back to the house where they lived, a haunted house. Clio wants answers about the past she doesn't remember, including who her mom really was. Clio decides to flip and sell the house, but the presence within has darker plans. It's happy she's back.

Play Nice is genuinely creepy, and in parts very scary. This is the kind

of book a reader is wise to only read during the daytime. The presence in the house is very unnerving, both in the present and in the flashbacks through the narrative of Clio's mom's book she wrote about the haunting. This is as much a psychological thriller and a family drama book as the reader is drawn back into the past along with Clio as she has to assess the past and integrate it with what she knows about her family. Clio has to face hard truths that go far beyond just growing up in a haunted house. She has to come to the realization that her happy family life and her carefree personality is built on a tenuous foundation of half-truths, deflections and manipulations that have masked deep and long-lasting familywide emotional trauma and dysfunction. This aspect of the book adds significantly to the disturbing nature of the narrative.

Play Nice hides an intensity beneath a bright surface that will leave readers feeling shaken and emotionally unbalanced when reality comes to life. Clio is a complex person, at times, unlikeable person, sometimes coming off as a bit of an unreliable narrator. But readers will feel invested in her experiences and well-being. This is an engrossing narrative that keeps the reader captivated until the end. While the pacing issues do make the ending a little less impactful, overall, Play Nice is a book with quite a visceral emotional punch. Readers who go into this for haunted house fun will find it demands a lot more from the experience. Danielle Hill


"Before healing begins, we must name the harm."





Hemlock and Silver is a retelling of the fairy tale Snow White that goes an unusual and intriguing direction with a unique point of view. Anja has a lifetime fixation on poisons. She's the one they call when a patient has a life-threatening encounter with toxins. The King comes for her help to save his daughter Snow, who is slowly dying from a poison, and no one can figure out why. Anja travels to his home in the desert where she is isolated, but the poisoner has found her. Can Anja save Snow before it's too late?

T. Kingfisher has written another story that takes what feels familiar and makes it entirely new. In this case, she expands on the concept of mirrors and apples in the fairy tale and re-imagines Snow White's character. This book

did suffer from a bit of a slow start as characters and settings were established. It will take some patience from a reader, but it pays off. The strength of this novel is Anja, a great character. Her encyclopedic knowledge of poisons and her world-view shaped from those experiences is captivating. She is down-to-earth and refreshing in her imperfections and admitted insecurities and flaws. Another successful aspect of this book is its tone. It gets very weird and there are some moments that are downright creepy, but there's also a wonderful sense of wry humor through Anja's point of view, and Javier, her bodyguard. There's also a cat, who plays a pivotal role in the story. While some readers may not completely connect to this as a Snow White"\\retelling, Kingfisher makes this fairy tale feel like an entirely new story with Hemlock and Silver.


