She has a deep love for storytelling, especially when it involves magic, romance, and hard-earned happy endings. Writing isn't just her job—it's who she is. Editing, too. She's worked with countless authors to shape their stories, and loves helping good books become great.

At home, she's surrounded by the best kind of chaos—three rescues who run the house. Milo, her Great Pyrenees, is gentle and big-hearted. Mia, her Pyrador, is an energetic wild child. And Millie, her tuxedo cat, rules it all with strong opinions (especially about lap space).

C. A. also runs an Etsy shop, Paper Dragon Trinkets, where she creates handmade bookmarks and dragon-inspired accessories—a little magic from her hoard for fellow readers.

She's a tattoo-loving, travel-chasing, coffee-obsessed book nerd—and wouldn't have it any other way.

### **Do you have a new book or series?**

I don't have a new series, but I am working on book four of my King's Riders series, and it's called *Dragon's Call*. I don't have hard

release date, but I hope to have it out by the end of 2026! It's exciting because I get to finally write about DRAGONS!

**Where did the idea for this story come from?**

This book is Lucan's story, who was in the previous books, and it's finally his turn. But the story does have two couples, since Lucan's bestie also finds his love in this book. It's part action-adventure, like the other stories, and of course, a happily ever after, or two. LOL.

**Who's your favorite character in your new book or series? Why?**

I don't really pick favorites. I would say some characters resonate differently with me than others. I love them all, they are like my kids. I have always loved Lucan, who was only 13 in the first book, and I knew he would have a story, so I am glad it's his turn.

**Are there specific people or events that helped shape the story?**

Not really. There are things that happen in the series that cause-and-effect the storyline, but each of my books is standalone within the series, so they are their own contained stories. It's just that my characters all know and care about each other.

**Do you get inspiration from personal experience or just plain imagination?**

I am sure I get inspiration from the world around me, but it's nothing on "purpose" as weird as that sounds. I am not a plotter—so I just sit down and write, it's called being a "pantser" (writing by the seat of my pants) so I don't plan what I write, and sometimes, I don't know what is going to come out, LOL. Sometimes I know general

scene facts, or what needs to happen next, but for me, I need the story form organically.

**Have you ever driven down a road or gone on vacation and thought, wow, this would make an awesome story?**

Oh, for sure all the time. But just because I have an idea doesn't mean I have time for it, LOL.

**Do you need silence or background noise when writing?**

Music, but it can't be familiar music that I know, so I won't get swept up in the words.

**How do you stay motivated?**

The voices in my head. No, seriously. LOL. My characters talk to me, and let me know if I'm too lazy.

**Do you take time off once a book is sent to the editor, or do you move on to the next story?**

Really depends on what's next and how driven I am to jump to the next story. Most times, when I finish a story, I grieve the couple, because their on-page journey is over. So it is always different, so sometimes it's a week and sometimes it's a month.

**It's time to sit back and relax. What's your go-to?**

Binging TV. Depending on the mood I am in as to what I want to watch but if I can't find something new, I can always put *Golden Girls* or the original *Charmed* on.

**Will you be attending any book signings or conventions?**

Yes, I have several on deck in 2026. On May 3, I will be at Tupps Brewery in McKinney, TX for Get Lit Adult Book Fair. August 15, I will be at an event called Book Me Romance, in Fort Smith, AR at the Fort Smith Convention Center. September 5, I will be back close to home in Fort Worth, TX for the Muses of Storytelling, and the last thing for sure right now is Buns & Roses, in Garland, TX on Oct 18, 2026. 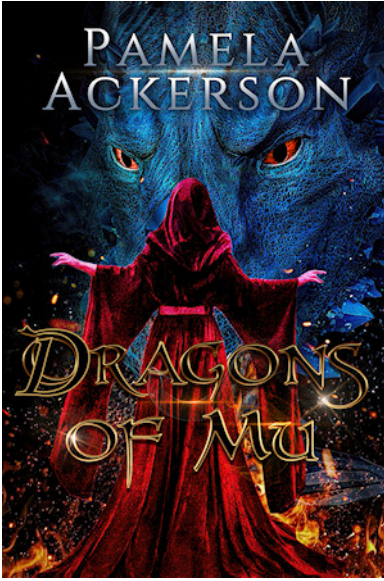

She watched as the men ran into the woods, searching for her.

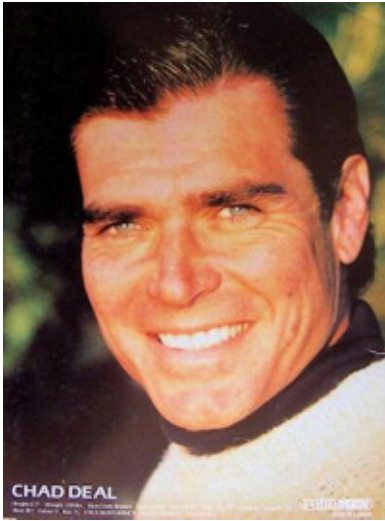
The dragon spoke in a deep, soothing voice, “Why are you dressed in that garb?”

## Cover Model Corner with Chad Deal



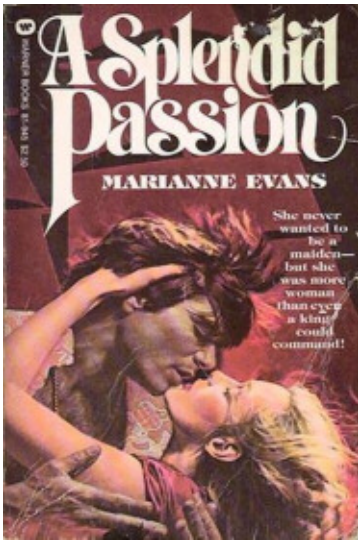
**Debra:** What was the first book cover you appeared on and how did it come about?

**Chad:** I do not remember the actual first book cover I did; however, it was one of my first bookings when I moved to Manhattan in 1976. I signed with Ford Men modeling agency and my booker asked if I would be interested in posing for a photographer who exclusively did book covers for romance and action paperbacks. She explained that even though the job paid less than the going rate at that time, if the photographer liked your work, you could be booked regularly. Being new to the city, I was ready to take pretty much any job (as long as it did not involve nudity), so off I went, not realizing at that time I was on the path to becoming the lead male model for the burgeoning paperback industry. My “paperback” career lasted for the full eleven years that I worked in NYC.

**Debra:** If you could do a photo shoot anywhere in the world for a cover, where would you most want to go? What sort of shoot would it be?

**Chad:** I think I would have to say Paris just because of the romance that even the name conjures up. Besides, are not the French known as lovers? LOL And besides, as a person who loves to cook, and the father of a chef, I love French food!

**Debra:** What other types of modeling have you done?



**Chad:** The mainstay of my modeling career was always catalogue. That was always steady once you became established with the different catalogue houses (photography studios that specialized in that field). However, I did many commercials and national ad campaigns over 20 years as I developed my career. I began modeling in 1965 in my hometown of Miami, FL and also worked as a watersports director while living on a 31-foot sailboat. I took two years off to serve our country in the Armed Services and upon my return to civilian life, began to complete my college education. I graduated Magna Cum Laude from Barry University in 1973 with a major in classical piano and a minor in drama. During this time, I was modeling and acting to pay for my schooling. My first actual job as a model/actor was a “stand in” for the father on the TV series “Flipper”, a show about a dolphin that was filming at the Miami Seaquarium. My next job was a bridal fashion show where I was the only groom paired with about 12-15 young ladies. By the end of that show, we were all in our underwear and I said to myself (as an 18-year-old male) I can grow to like this! I worked in Chicago for a year (1975) then moved to the “mecca” of modeling, NYC in 1976. During my 11 years in the city, I also made a couple of trips to Milan and Hamburg which were two hotspots for modeling in Europe.

**Debra:** What was your most memorable photo shoot and why?

**Chad:** A couple of my best memories would be visiting the rainforest during the filming of a commercial for the Puerto Rican Tourist Board, a trip to the Inca ruins in Peru for a catalog shoot, a series of Australian cigarette commercials in Quebec, and a trip to

Sedona's red rock country where the crew and I travelled by horseback to shoot for my long-time client BVD underwear. This was the culmination of their ad campaign where I was featured as a modern-day cowboy.

**Debra:** Beyond modeling, what other projects keep you busy?

**Chad:** I enjoy playing music, especially classical piano. Even though I have a BA degree in Music from Barry University, I have never sought out a career in that direction. I was the main drummer for an African dance troop for 6 years which I found greatly enhanced my understanding of rhythms.

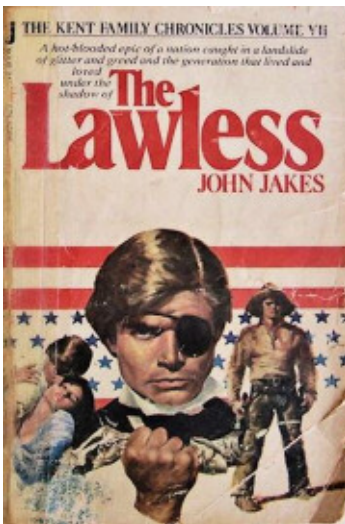
Then there is surfing which I love doing, and in recent years I have begun to deepen my studies of martial arts, an interest of mine since the late 1960's.

**Debra:** What's one question you wish an interviewer would ask?

**Chad:** What is my outlook on life? "The Golden Rule"

**Debra:** If you wrote a book, what would it be about?

**Chad:** How each side of my family came to the US and what their journeys were like. Basically, my origin so I could leave that heritage to my children's children.



**Debra:** Your fitness level is beyond the average persons. What is your exercise routine and what sort of nutrition plan do you follow to achieve and maintain your level of fitness?

**Chad:** I do not have a regimented workout program. I train martial arts on a daily basis (sometimes reading) and teach a 2-hour class twice a week on my own and assist a friend with his school 2-hour classes twice a week. I

enjoy being in the ocean either body surfing or with a surfboard. I also try to get in a once-a-year snow ski trip.

**Debra:** When traveling, it can be a challenge to maintain a fitness routine and a nutrition plan. How do you meet that challenge?

**Chad:** Martial art training is something you can take with you anywhere and I usually try to visit other schools when I am traveling. I consider myself an accomplished cook and enjoy preparing my own meals, so I tend not to eat out very often. Even though I try my best to eat organically produced foods I do not constrict myself to any particular diet.

**Debra:** If you could share three simple fitness tips the average romance reader could do every day to stay healthy, what would they be?

**Chad:** Breathe deeply and investigate Chinese Qi Gong. Take walks/hikes or any outdoor activity for that matter. What matters most to me is fresh air, light workouts, good food, and exercising the brain.

**Debra:** It's your birthday dinner and calories don't count. What's on the menu and what are you drinking?

**Chad:** A salmon filet smothered in fresh ginger and lemon and a stir fry of "cole" veggies with a light vinaigrette, small side of quinoa and a tequila with OJ and pomegranate juice.

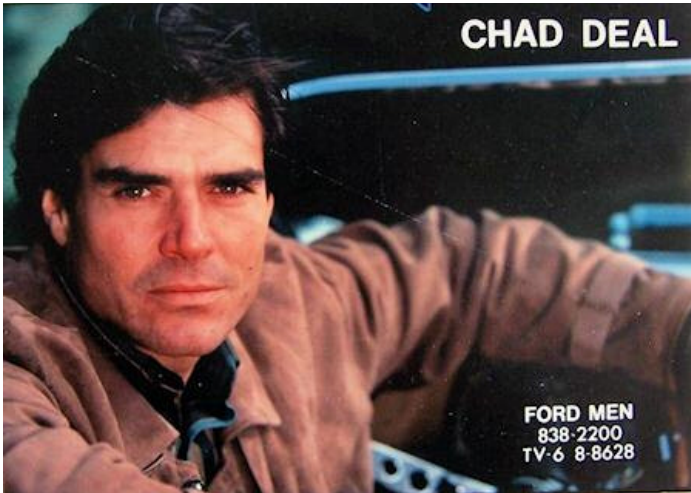
**Debra:** Describe the perfect romantic evening.
